

Friends of Eastwood Farm Logo



This picture is the logo used by Friends of Eastwood Farm as a symbol for their group. You may think it looks like a bald man with a moustache winking but it is a picture showing some of the most important things about Eastwood Farm Local Nature Reserve.

The curve at the top is the Avon river that runs round the lower edge of the Local Nature Reserve. The flooding from the river make the special water meadow area.

The winking eye is the lagoon with its two islands that swans and ducks love to visit and nest on.

The round eye is the "bomb hole". This is a really deep pond with a dipping platform. Local people think it was made by a bomb dropping there in the Second World War.

The moustache is a bird. It is a heron, a long-legged bird that stands in ponds and at the edge of streams and river waiting to catch food like small fish and frogs is its long beak. Herons are frequent visitors to Eastwood Farm.
